


## JANUARY 18, 2023 MEETING SPEAKER'S BIO Pat Hummer, Senior Harbor Patrol Officer



The mission of the Ventura Harbor Patrol is to, "Provide a safe boating environment through education, enforcement, and service." For the past 32 years, Senior Harbor Patrol Officer Pat Hummer has helped Ventura Harbor Patrol fulfill its mission by enforcing the Ventura Harbor Ordinance, boating law, and specific sections of other codes that relate to his duties, with a focus on education rather than punishment.

Although he works 12 hour shifts, Pat says he arrives to work each day with a smile on his face. Yes, Pat enjoys the cool equipment used by the Harbor

Patrol, but he says his main goal and joy is keeping citizens safe, either through education, enforcement, or rescue. As a trained Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Pat has been called upon many times to provide services and assist other agencies in rescues within the boundaries of the Harbor Patrol's jurisdiction. However, when necessary, he has been called upon to provide services outside the Harbor Patrol's jurisdiction, as was the case when Pat and two of his fellow Harbor Patrol Officers responded on January 31, 2002, when Alaskan Airlines flight 261 crashed near Anacapa Island. So, truly, a Harbor Patrol Officer's job is not all fun and games, but Pat\_still manages to keep a smile on his face.

#### WHALE WATCHING WITH ISLAND PACKERS SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 11, 2023 9:30 AM to 1:00 PM Price for club members: \$40 (regular price is \$44 as of Feb 1)

As announced in our November newsletter, to coincide with the gray whales' southward migration to the breeding and calving grounds in Baja Mexico, our club booked 14 spots for a whale watching trip with Island Packers. January through March is an ideal time to see migrating gray whales along the California coast as they get closer to their winter homes in

the lagoons of Mexico. It is even possible for us to see some northward migrating whales who arrived early to the breeding grounds and are now heading back up to the Artic.

#### As of January 2, 2023, we have filled 9 of our available 14 spots. If you are interested in one or more of our remaining 5 spots, please email our Dive Coordinator at dive@channelislandsdivers.org. A signup sheet will be also be available at our January 18 General Meeting.

Here are the specifics for the trip:

- Price: \$40 for club members. (Non-members must book directly with Islands Packers at the regular price of \$44)
- Departure: Channel Islands Harbor, 3550 Harbor Boulevard, Oxnard, CA 93035
- After the cruise, we will meet at Topper's Pizza at the corner or Victoria Avenue and Channel Islands Boulevard for lunch. (Members pay for their own lunches.)

As mentioned at our November meeting, the regular price for the *Spectre* has increased to \$175, but boat management has continued to offer a wonderful group discount to Channel Islands Divers. 
