


The last meeting at Pizza Man Dans ran way over and for that I apologize. I won't let that happen again, especially for our first night in our new room. First impressions do count!

Club members Heather Moine & Donald Lockwood present: THE MALDIVES

Heather Moine and Donald Lockwood are excited to share their Maldives SCUBA diving experience with CID through the lens of their underwater cameras.

In early 2019, Heather and Donald met and quickly realized each had experience diving. As their relationship continued, they also became dive buddies and started regularly diving the Santa Barbara Channel, mostly the mainland, on the hunt for nudibranchs. After keeping a regular pattern of diving in our rocky-reef kelp forests, they fantasized about diving in warm water together. Jump to Maldives, July 2022. Heather captures her experiences with a point-and-shoot/happy-snappy Olympus TG-6 with housing and video lights, and Donald captures mostly marine life with a Sony A7 III with a Sigma 105 macro lens. Their photos will highlight the beauty of the Maldives and the diversity of marine life it has to offer.

NEW CLUB EVENT: ANACAPA SEAGULL ROOKERY TRIP Saturday, June 17, 2023 9:30 AM to 3:30 PM Group Rate: \$59 per person (*club members only*) Led by club members, and Channel Islands Naturalists, STEVE PETERSON & BILL WEINERTH



NOTE: If you have any expired gift certificates from Island Packers, manager Cherryl Connally said the certificates will be honored for club members So, take advantage of this trip, and use your old Island Packers' gift certificates!

Anacapa is the smallest of the Northern Channel Islands. It is actually three islands, and It is also the only one of the islands off our coast that does not have fresh water. However, the lack of fresh water does not mean that Anacapa is still not a spectacular place to visit. The 1.5-mile, round trip hike from the 1932 Anacapa Island Lighthouse and the National Park visitor center, reveals one of the best views in the park; inspirational even on a foggy day.

Western gulls almost exclusively breed on islands off the coast of California, Oregon, and Washington, and Anacapa Island is one of the largest breeding centers for western gulls in the U.S. Anacapa's isolation and freedom from predators, such as foxes and nonnative rats, are crucial for these seabirds to successfully breed and rear their young. The breeding/nesting period is May through July, and approximately 5,500 nests are observed each year. A western gull's nest starts as a scrape or depression in the ground, with twigs and grasses added to form a nest bowl in which the eggs are laid. Some gulls prefer to build their nests in small cliffside caves. They usually lay 2-3 eggs, which are incubated for 4 weeks. We are scheduling our trip

during the month of June in order to have the best opportunity to observe the small chicks and their downy feathers, which they have during the first month of life.

Other things to know about the Anacapa Seagull Rookery Trip:

- We are booking **8 spots** at the group rate for club members. More spots can be added, if needed.
- The \$59 group rate is only available to club members. Non-members must book directly with Island Packers at the regular rate of \$63 per person.
- Bring a jacket, hat, sunscreen, and wear study shoes. The island can often become very windy as sea conditions change during the day.
- This is an all day trip, so bring plenty of water and a picnic lunch. Leave NO TRASH behind!
- The 1.5 mile hike through the nesting grounds is an easy one, but we have to climb 157 stairs from the landing to reach the lookout at 200 feet above sea level.

HARMON CANYON HIKE SATURDAY, MAY 20, 2023 9:00am-Noon Free to members and non-members (Lunch at Sushi Fresh, Ventura, after the hike)

The Harmon Canyon Preserve is Ventura's first large-scale nature preserve, and, at 2,100 acres, visitors enjoy hills and canyons that feature oak groves, stream crossings, and breathtaking views of the Southern California mountain ranges, coastline, and the Channel Islands National Park islands.

The response to the announcement of our first club hike of 2023 has been outstanding!

Since the hike was announced at our February meeting and in our newsletter, **12 club members have already signed up** for this club event. By May, our much needed rain should have passed us by, so don't miss the opportunity to take advantage of this beautiful hike, literally in our own backyards!

Things to know about hiking the Harmon Canyon Preserve:

- Location: 7511 Foothill Road, Ventura (Approach from Kimball Road, and from Foothill turn right onto Mittie Place to reach trailhead parking. NO LEFT TURN IS ALLOWED FROM FOOTHILL ONTO MCVITTIE.)
- The hike is of MODERATE difficulty.
- Elevation from the Preserve entrance to the Overlook Bench is 1,007 feet.
- The main Overlook Bench Trail can become very warm due to absence of shade, **so please be sure to bring plenty of water with you.** May is Springtime, so also bring plenty of mosquito spray with you.

After our hike, we will gather at Sushi Fresh on the corner of Victoria Avenue and Telegraph Road for a well-deserved lunch. Club members and guests pay for their own lunches.

The response to our announcement at the last club meeting about our partnership with Channel Islands Dive Adventures (CIDA) for a Monterey Weekend and Boat Dive has been very positive. Seventeen club members have already signed up for the trip, and **we have filled all 10 spots** for the Saturday, October 21 dive trip aboard the *Beachhopper II*. If you wish to go on the boat dive, remember, cancellations always happen, so a waiting list will be available at our March 15 meeting or you can get your name on the waiting list by email the Dive Coordinator at dive@channelislandsdivers.org.

For those going on the Beachhopper II, **tanks are not provided**, so bring two (2) of your own tanks. You may also rent tanks at *www.beachhopper2.com*. If you are going to rent tanks, do so well in advance of our trip.

NOTE: USE THE HOTEL'S WEBSITE TO MAKE YOUR ROOM RESERVATIONS. When booking my own room at the Lone Oak Lodge, I discovered the reservation desk didn't yet have the off-season prices in their system. The price quoted to me was almost \$300 more than our off-season prices should have been. I went to the website at *www.loneoaklodge.com* and found the nightly prices were what we had originally expected. In addition to the high quote for the room, I also discovered Monterey has a very high sales tax rate of 12.80%, and the city tacks on a \$64 tourism fee for all transactions.

We are still finalizing the schedule for the weekend, but this is what we have planned so far:

- Thursday, 10/19 Arrive late in the day.
- Friday, 10/20 Morning whale watching trip with CIDA. Make your reservation directly with the charter operator at: https://gowhales.com. At around 6:00 PM, we will have a group potluck at the Lone Oak Lodge.
- Saturday, 10/21 Two tank dive aboard the Beachhopper II (members only). Possibility of Ranger-led hike or other activity for non-divers.
